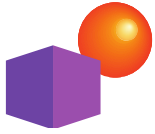
- Easy access off I-225 or I-70

Get ready!

- Please update your tournament data forms and submit before Wednesday April 3rd.
 - o This allows us time to review and give any feedback.
- Please make sure your team has addressed any issues brought up in regionals.
 - o If there were items left off your expense reports, please look at the Rules of the Road.
 - Everything that contributes to the solution presented must be included.
 - If you already had the clothes used as a costume, it must be listed at a garage sale price.
 - If you only used a portion of purchased items, use a reduced price.
 - If you had items donated – such as artistic materials, use a portion price.
 - Review carefully any exempt items.
 - o It is ok to change anything in your presentation. Just make sure those changes are in the tournament data forms.
 - Did the team **Reimagine** the Visual Art work so that the appraisers can “see” the original through a performance art genre?
 - Is there a **Static** and **Dynamic** character?
 - Is there a piece of **Kinetic** art that is not a part of the **Reimagined** art that uses some sort of technical method?
 - Are there 2 **Team Choice Elements** that show off the team’s talents, but are not a scored element?
 - o We encourage teams to write or dictate their own tournament data forms. This will help immensely when the appraisers speak to the teams after the challenge.
 - o Don’t forget to include a picture of your Visual Art form.

On the big day!

- Please arrive at Hinkley at least 1 hour before your team challenge or instant challenge (whichever comes first)
 - o We encourage new teams to watch older or more experienced teams. Get ideas for next year and be inspired!

- **However**, don't watch the same challenge until after you perform. Go ahead and watch a different challenge if there is time.
- The common space to hang out is upstairs in the two cafeterias upstairs.
- Please arrive in the prep area 20 minutes before your team challenge time. Only team members and the team manager(s) are allowed in the prep area. We LOVE the support of families and friends, they can go straight to the audience entrance.
- Teams and families – please stay quiet near the performance site as the noise from outside the room can be very distracting to the performing teams. Use the time before to get out your energy in one of the wonderful outdoor areas.
