Dear 2025 Technical Teams,

We can't wait to see your builds and breaks!

As far as logistics go this year the technical challenge (elementary, middle, and senior levels) will be held in **the**Main Gym which has wood floors and a standard doorway for teams to enter through. There will be space in the
gym for teams to get organized before their performances. We ask that you do not bring your props into the gym
until 90 minutes before your presentation time.

There will be four sites operating simultaneously in the gym: two Technical sites and two Engineering sites. If you bring your props into the gym before your scheduled start time, please be respectful of the ongoing presentations. On the flipside, some level of background is unavoidable during your presentation, so be prepared to project.

You will be dropping off your props at the intersection of Larimer and 11th Street. There will be 6 parking spots available for prop drop off. You will walk toward the Tivoli and enter the door on the north side of the building. There is a flight of stairs you go up. **YOU MUST BE VERY QUIET** bringing in your props as performances will be in process!!! Proceed to the center area. No teams should arrive more than 90 minutes ahead of time. Please move your vehicle as soon as you can.

We will be doing pre-Prep as well as day of Prep for State this year. Please make sure to have all your paperwork submitted by the paperwork submission deadline (Wednesday April 2nd) so that the Prep appraisers and ACM's can look it over prior to tournament day.

We would also like to draw your attention to our challenge's one published clarification which reads:

In the Challenge, Section I.C.6 should read: "If your team is not using all Stack Items in a Stack, any unused Stack Item(s) should be placed together and outside the 8ft x 8ft (2.44m x 2.44m) taped area of the largest Target Zone (see Figure B) so that Appraisers can easily identify and record only the Stack Item(s) that were used for that Stack. During Stack Assembly and Stack Destruction, any unused Stack Items must not interact with the Assembly Equipment, Destruction Equipment, or Stack Items that are used in the Stack."
